Proverbs 22:6 says, “Train a child up in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.” The wisdom of this proverb encourages us to take seriously the responsibility to teach our kids about God, His Word, and His ways. The Core Seminar kids track covers the following three areas:

- * **Gospel Project Review:** Each week during our main service the children at Water’s Edge are walking through a curriculum called “The Gospel Project.” The Gospel Project is a three year, chronological exploration of the Bible. Each lesson is designed to show how the Bible points to Jesus. During Core Seminars, our kids will begin with a short review of the previous week’s lesson.
- * **Scripture Memorization:** Special time and attention will be given to helping kids memorize significant portions of scripture. A variety of methods will be used to accomplish this goal.
- * **Bible Basics:** Kids will also be shown how to navigate their Bibles, memorizing all 66 books in order of appearance!

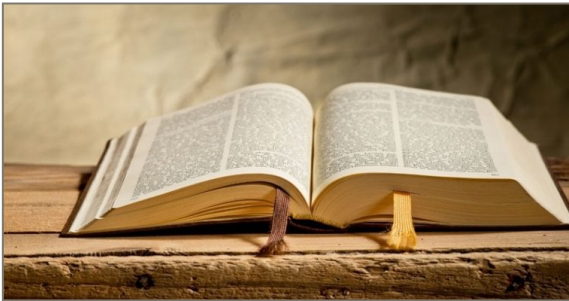

Track 1: Basics

Track 3: Church History and Theology

The Bible Overview track focuses on the enhancing our understanding of the Scriptures by providing an overview of each book. Courses include:
